Carter opens all military occupations, positions to women

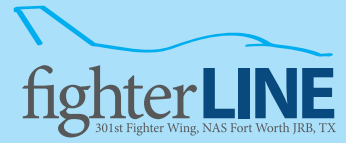
Defense Secretary Ash Carter announced today that beginning in January 2016, all military occupations and positions will be open to women, without exception. [Read more](#)
