Another Airmen's Panel a complete success

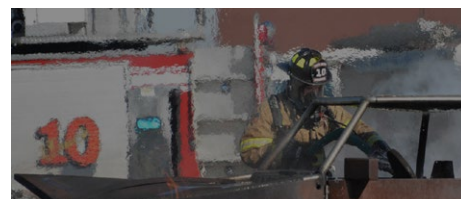

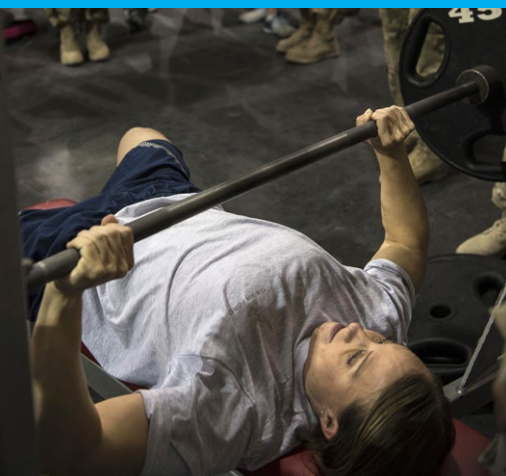
